



WATER MAIN CONSTRUCTION: 33RD TO 48TH STREET

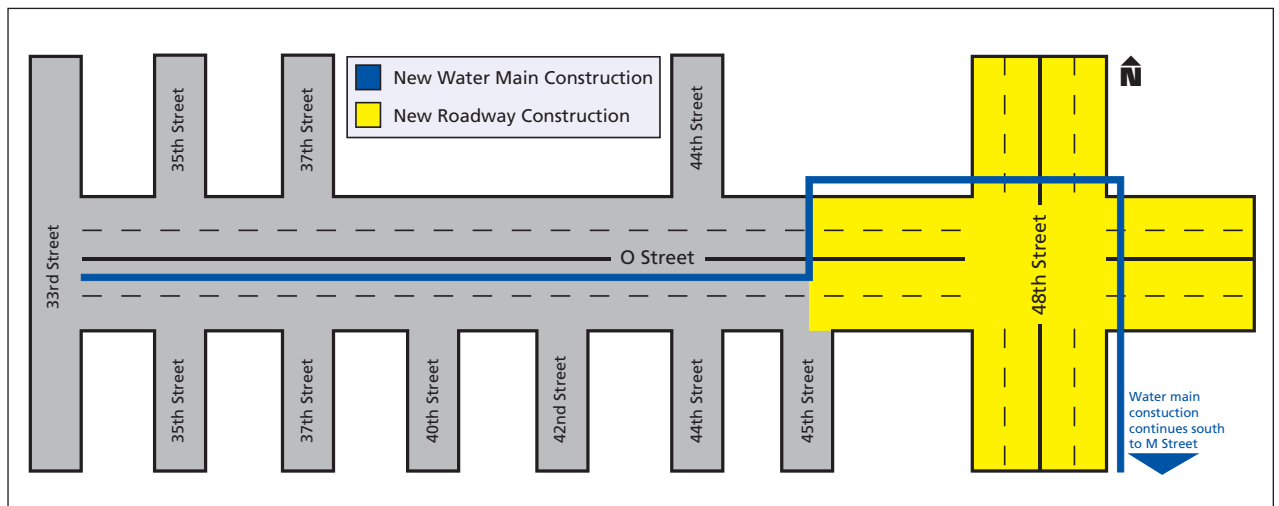
Project Update

As part of the O Street project, a new water main will be built along O Street from 33rd Street to 48th Street, and along 48th Street from O Street to M Street. The existing water main in these areas is constructed of cast iron pipe and is over 80 years old.

Due to the corrosive nature of the soils and the age of the water main, the existing pipe has experienced failures in recent years. This has impacted not only water service to area businesses and residences, but has also resulted in closure of portions of O Street to traffic to allow the water main to be repaired. The size of the new water main will be increased to enhance the water service for current and future users in this area.

Water main work will begin in February 2006, and is anticipated to be complete in early July. During this time, traffic along O Street between 31st and 44th Streets will be restricted to two lanes—one eastbound and one westbound with center left-turn lanes provided at key intersections.

This work will require short-term closures on 33rd Street and at 40th Street to complete portions of this work. During construction of the water main between 33rd and 45th Street, access to properties and businesses will be maintained from either O Street or the adjacent side streets.
